- Know your strengths and weaknesses
- DO NOT TRY AND COMPLETE EVERYTHING YOURSELF!!!
- Find someone to take on the AV duties (unless that is you)
- Set a schedule for collecting all footage/photos/etc... that fits YOU!

Know your team:

- Does this particular group of kids fit the requirements?
- Brainstorm with team to choose team philosophy, motto, and how you will creatively define SUCCESS
- Whatever you do... BE POSITIVE!

Delegate responsibilities:

- Choose ONE area you most comfortable with and complete it-Keep in mind you will need to oversee the entire process
- · Utilize assistant cheer coaches in key areas
- Involve trustworthy cheer parents to assist you in community projects
- Use Senior team members to complete specific pages of your portfolio or sections of your video

All of the following are sections of the portfolio to be submitted by each nominated team:

- COVER PAGE
- SQUAD GPA
- COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

• TEAM ESSAY

A comprehensive essay of your team's philosophy of cheerleading and an explanation of your team motto (stated on your cover page) in 75-100 words

• TEAM PHOTOS

Portfolio must include at least one current photo of the team in uniform

HONORS, AWARDS, & RECOGNITIONS (CHEERLEADING)

List with a description...may include individual merit, or program merit

HONORS, AWARDS, & RECOGNITIONS (OUTSIDE OF CHEERLEADING)

List with description

• OTHER SPORTS & ACTIVITIES

List of any other sports and/or activities in which the cheerleaders of the program are involved

• ENDORSEMENTS

Minimum 3, maximum 8 letters of endorsement. MUST include one letter from the Athletic Director and one letter from a community member. May also include (but is not limited to) parents, students, faculty, or alumni.

Team of the Year Video Requirements

Each nominated team must include a video which includes three required sections. Videos may have the maximum length of 15 minutes.

1. TECHNICAL-15 points

- Dance/ motions
- Jumps/tumbling
- Stunts

2. SPORTSMANSHIP- 40 points

- Shows evidence of crowd involvement, sportsmanship, and team unity. May include (but is not limited to) interviews throughout the community, game footage, athlete interviews, footage from service projects
- Community service
- Team essay
- Academic Excellence

3. CREATIVE SECTION- 45 points

- Program will creatively answer the question: HOW DOES YOUR TEAM ACHIEVE SUCCESS? (HDYTAC)
- Portfolio
- Video
- Endorsements
